

- 1st reference to Saul (Paul) in the Bible — Acts 7:58
- Saul — Jewish name
- Paul — Roman name
- Descendent of the tribe of Benjamin — Romans 11:1
- Born in Tarsus of Cilicia
- Educated in Jerusalem — Taught by Gamaliel
- Died in Rome Italy
- His taught trade was that of a tentmaker — Acts 18:3
- 1st recorded words of Paul - “. . . Who are You, Lord . . . ?” Acts 9:5
- Baptized in Damascus — Acts 22:16; Acts 9:18
- 1st reference to Paul preaching — Acts 9:20 (Synagogues of Damascus)
- Content of Paul’s Preaching — Christ is the Son of God. Acts 9:20
- 1st recorded miracle — Acts 13:8-11 - (Paphos in Cyprus)
- 1st time Saul is referred to as Paul — Acts 13:9 (Paphos in Cyprus)
- 1st recorded sermon — Acts 13:16-41 (Antioch in Pisidia)
- 1st reference to Paul as an Apostle — Acts 14:1 (Iconium)
- 1st recorded healing miracle — Acts 14:8-10 (Lystra)
- 1st mention of Paul’s appointing elders — Acts 14:23
- Received the “Macedonian Call” while at Troas — Acts 14:23
- 1st recorded arrest — Acts 16:19-23 (Philippi)
- 1st recorded letter - 1 Thessalonians (written from Corinth)
- Last recorded letter — 2 Timothy (written from Rome)
