

Berea



- A city of Macedonia to which Paul with Silas and Timotheus went when persecuted at Thessalonica (**Acts 17:10, 13**), and from which also he was compelled to withdraw, when he fled to the seacoast and thence sailed to **Athens (14, 15)**
- Sopater, one of Paul's companions belonged to this city, and his conversion probably took place at this time (**Acts 20:4**).
- It is now called Verria.
