- Bethsaida means:
 - “House of the fisher.”
 - “House of the hunter.”
 - Located on the northern shore of the Sea of Galilee.
 - Called a city in **Luke 9:20**
 - Called a village in **Mark 8:26**
 - Philip, Andrew, and Peter were from Bethsaida. **John 1:44** — “Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.”
 - (Peter also had a house in Capernaum. **Matthew 8:14** — “And when Jesus was come into Peter’s house, he saw his wife’s mother laid, and sick of a fever.”)
