

En-gedi



- Its early name was Hazazon-tamar.
- Located on the western shore of the Dead Sea.
- A rich plain one-half mile square and fed by a fountain issuing 400 feet up the cliff.
- It was attacked by the federation of kings in Abraham's day. **Genesis 14:7**
- David hid here from Saul, and in one of the caves cut off a piece of Saul's skirt from his robe. **1 Samuel 23:29; 1 Samuel 24**
