A. D. 27 { Baptism administered by John was IMMERSION

A. D. 30 { Baptism administered by the Authority of Jesus Christ was IMMERSION



UNSCRIPTURAL CHANGES

A. D. 251 { The first historical occurrence of POURING (Affusion) was the "baptism of Novation as he lay on his deathbed

A. D. 1311 { SPRINKLING as a form of "baptism" was authorized in A.D. 1131 by the Roman Catholic Church and was legalized at the Council of Ravenna
