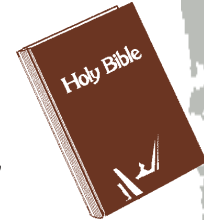


# Deacons

## 1 Timothy 3:8-13



- ▶ **“DEACON” is derived from the Greek word “DIAKONOS” — meaning: Servant, attendant, minister.**
- ▶ **A DEACON is a helper, minister, or servant in the church in contrast to an elder who is an overseer.**
- ▶ **The New Testament says little about the specific duties of deacons.**
- ▶ **The office of a deacon is an honorable position in the Church.**
- ▶ **Acts 6:1-7 seems to indicate a need and work for deacons.**

*“Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons.” Philipians 1:1*
