

# Holy Spirit Baptism Ended by 64 A.D.



**TWO BAPTISMS WERE IN EFFECT IN A.D. 30 ON THE DAY OF PENTECOST**

- Holy Spirit baptism - Acts 2:1-4
- Water baptism – Acts 2:38

**TWO BAPTISMS WERE IN EFFECT IN A.D. 41 AT THE HOUSE OF CORNELIUS**

- Holy Spirit baptism – Acts 10:44
- Water baptism – Acts 10:47-48

**ONE BAPTISM WAS IN EFFECT WHEN PAUL AUTHORED THE EPHESIANS LETTER IN ABOUT 64 A.D.**

- Ephesians 4:5 - “One baptism.”
- Holy Spirit baptism was to be administered by Christ – Matthew 3:11
- The baptism of the Great Commission (water baptism) was administered by men and was to last until the end of the world (Matthew 28:20)
- The only baptism administered by man was water baptism.

**CONCLUSION: The one baptism of Ephesians 4:5 is water baptism!**
