

The Holy Spirit in the Old Testament - Part 2

The difference between the Holy Spirit's activity in the Old Testament and His activity in the New Testament is best seen in John 14:17 - "Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it sees Him not, neither knows Him: but you know Him; for he dwells with you, and shall be in you."

**In the Old Testament the Holy Spirit was "WITH" them.
In the New Testament the Holy Spirit is "IN" them.**

SUMMARY OF THE ACTIVITY OF THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE OLD TESTAMENT:

1. He appeared in creation. (Genesis 1:2; Psalm 104:30) →
2. He appeared in revealing dreams. (Genesis 41:15, 38) →
3. He gave prophetic vision. (Judges 24:2; Micah 3:8) →
4. He gave power to the rulers. (Judges 6:34; 1 Samuel 16:13) →
5. He revealed Himself in workmanship. (Exodus 21:1-5) →
