

The Herods - Part 3

HEROD PHILIP I

- The son of Herod the Great and Mariamne
- Married Herodias, the sister of Agrippa I, by whom he had a daughter, Salome
- Due to his mother's treachery, he was excluded from having a share of his father's possessions
- Occupied a private station in life

HEROD PHILIP II

- Tetrarch of Batanea and Trachonitis A.D. 34
- Son of Herod the Great by his 5th wife, Cleopatra
- Married Salome, the daughter of Herod Philip I and Herodias (Mark 6:22)
- Built the city of Caesarea Philippi
- Died without an heir in A.D. 34
- His tetrarchy was made part of Syria then assigned to Herod Agrippa I in A.D. 37



DRUSILLA

- Born in A.D. 38
- Daughter of Agrippa I and Kypros
- Sister of Bernice and Agrippa II
- Married Azizus, king of Emesa
- Later became the 3rd wife of Antonius Felix, procurator of Judea from A.D. 52-60
- Her only son by Felix, Antonius Agrippa, died in the eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in A.D. 79

HERODIAS

- Daughter of Aristobulus
- The wife of Herod Philip and the mistress of Herod Antipas (Matthew 14:3-6; Mark 6:17-23; Luke 3:19)

DRUSILLA

- Known only as the daughter of Herodias in the Bible (Matthew 15:6; Mark 6:22)
- Daughter of Herod Philip II and Herodias
- Her dancing on the birthday of her stepfather resulted in the beheading of John the Baptist (Mark 6:14-29)
- Married Philip II and Aristobulus II
