■ Piece of money - gold, alloy, silver: Tax for two	64 cents	(Matthew 17:27)

■ Farthing - quadran: copper	1/4 cent	(Matthew 5:26)
■ Farthing - quadrante: copper	1 cent	(Matthew 10:29)
■ Penny - denarius: copper or silver	16 cents	Matthew 22:19
■ Talent - attic	\$960	Matthew 25:15
