- His name means “Drawn forth, Taken out of the water.”
- Moses was born in Egypt.
- His parents were Amram & Jochebed.
- Moses:
 - Was the youngest of three children.
 - Had one brother—Aaron.
 - Had one sister—Miriam
 - Was the grandson of Kohath.
 - Was the great grandson of Levi.
- Was educated in the palace of Pharaoh.
- Married Zipporah, daughter of Jethro.
- Had two sons:
 - Gershom
 - Eliezer
- The years of Moses
 - Lived a total of 120 years (1526-1406 B.C.)
 - Deuteronomy 34:17
 - Spent 1st forty years in Egypt (1526-1486 B.C.)
 - Acts 7:22-23
 - Spent 2nd forty years in the land of Midian (1486-1446 B.C.)
 - Exodus 2:15
 - Spent the final forty years leading the children of Israel through the wilderness (1446-1406 B.C.)
 - Deuteronomy 8:2
- Wrote five books of the Bible plus the 90th Psalm

- The story of Moses constitutes about one-seventh of the whole Bible.
- The story of Moses is about two-thirds as large as the New Testament.
- Moses was 40 years old when he slew the Egyptian.
- Moses was 80 years old when he was called to lead Israel out of Egypt.
- Moses was the only man in the Bible to have God as his undertaker.
