

Key Tabernacle Pieces - Part 1

NAME	FUNCTION & SIGNIFICANCE
ARK OF THE COVENANT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A golden rectangular box that contained the Ten Commandments• Symbolized God's covenant with Israel's people• Located in the Most Holy Place
ATONEMENT COVER	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The lid to the Ark of the Covenant• The Mercy Seat• Symbolized the presence of God among His people
CURTAIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The curtain that divided the two sacred rooms of the Tabernacle-the Holy Place and the Most Holy Place• Symbolized how the people were separated from God because of sin
TABLE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A wooden table located in the Holy Place of the Tabernacle• The Bread of the Presence and various utensils were kept on this table
BREAD OF THE PRESENCE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Twelve loaves of bread, one for each tribe of Israel• Symbolized the spiritual nourishment God offers His people
