

Old Testament Facts & Figures - Part 3

- 300 years between Genesis and Exodus.
- 400 years between Malachi (Old Testament) and Matthew (New Testament).
- 1656 years from Adam to the Flood.
- 427 years from the Flood to Abraham.
- Adam's life was contemporary with Methuselah for 243 years.
- Methuselah was contemporary with Noah for 600 years.
- 126 years between the death of Adam and the birth of Noah.
- Noah lived a total of 950 years: 600 before the Flood & 350 after the Flood.
- Noah died two years before Abraham was born.
- Abraham had been in Canaan 75 years when Shem died.
- Adam was alive at the birth of great-great-great-great-great grandchildren.
- Noah lived to the 9th generation of his own descendents.
- Before the Flood, people lived to a great age. After the Flood, there was a gradual reduction in the length of life.
- The confusing of languages occurred about 101 years after the Flood and 326 years before the call of Abraham.
- Traditional site of the Tower of Babel is at Borsip
