

# Baptism for the Remission of Sins

- **Baptism** is from the Greek word “**baptizo**” meaning a burial, immersion.
- Ephesians 4:4-5 - “There is . . . **one** baptism.”

## Mark 16:16 -

“He who believes and is baptized will be saved . . .”

## Galatians 3:27 -

“For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”

## Acts 2:38 -

“ . . . Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins . . .”

## Acts 22:16 -

“And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.”

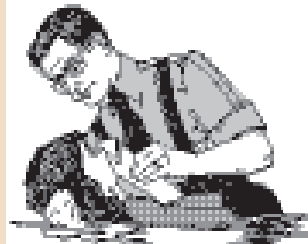


## 1 Peter 3:21 -
