Acts 19:1-7

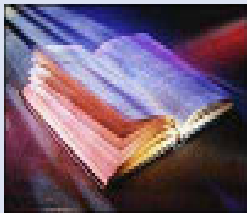


WHO SHOULD NOT BE REBAPTIZED?

THOSE WHO REPENTED OF THEIR SINS, CONFESSED THEIR FAITH IN CHRIST, AND WERE IMMERSED IN WATER FOR THE REMISSION OF THEIR SINS, WERE SINCERE, AND KNEW WHAT THEY WERE DOING.

THOSE WHO WERE BAPTIZED SCRIPTURALLY AND LATER SINNED.

THOSE WHO WERE BAPTIZED SCRIPTURALLY AND THEN ENTERED SOME DENOMINATION. THEY NEED TO REPENT.
