Acts 16:19-31

The Philippian Jailor’s question is a five-part question. Profitable study can be had by examining the question in reverse order.

1. **TO BE SAVED** { “What Must I Do **to Be Saved?**”
Saved from What? Saved from Sin



2. **DO** { “What Must I **Do** To Be Saved?”
Things Not to Do & Things To Do



3. **I** { “What Must **I** Do to Be Saved?”
Personal. No One Can Do It For Me

4. **MUST** { “What Must I **Must** Do to Be Saved?”
Some Imperatives. Not Optional

5. **WHAT** { “**What** Must I Do to Be Saved?”
Something Definite to Be Do

- The Gospel Must be **BELIEVED**

- Sins Must be **REPENTED** of
 - Luke 13:3, 5

- Christ Must be **CONFESSED**
 - Matthew 10:32-33
 - Romans 10:10
- There Must be **BAPTISM**
(Immersion) for the Remission
(forgiveness) of Sins
 - Acts 2:38
 - 1 Peter 3:21
- There Must be **CHRISTIAN GROWTH** and **FAITHFULNESS**
 - 1 Peter 2:2
 - Revelation 2:10
 - 2 Peter 3:18
