- It takes the baptism of that denomination to put one into that denomination.



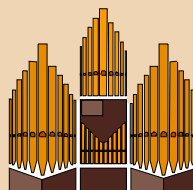
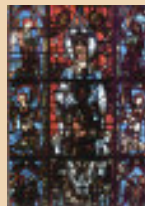
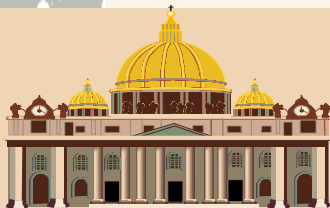
THE BIBLE TEACHES . . .

THERE IS NOT A WRONG WAY TO BE RIGHTLY BAPTIZED!



Denominational Baptism is Wrong Because . . .

IT CAUSES ONE TO WEAR THE WRONG NAME



- One baptized into a denominational church by a denominational baptism invariably causes one to wear the name of that denomination
