

Baptism for the Remission of Sins

- **Baptism** is from the Greek word “baptizo” meaning a burial, immersion.
- Ephesians 4:4, 5 – There is . . . **one baptism.**”



Mark 16:16–

“He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved . . .”

Galatians 3:27–

“For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.”

Acts 2:38 –

“ . . . Repent and be baptized everyone of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins . . .”



Acts 22:16 –

“And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.”

1 Peter 3:21–

“The like figure whereunto even baptism doth also now save us . . .”

BAPTISM IS ESSENTIAL FOR SALVATION

- Baptism is for the remission of sins — Acts 2:38
- Baptism washes away one’s sins — Acts 22:16
- Baptism is involved in saving men — 1 Peter 3:21
- Belief + Baptism = Salvation — Mark 16:16
- God commands baptism — Acts 10:47-48
- Christ commands baptism — Matthew 28:19-20
