- AT THIS POINT IN CONVERSION THE TERMS “**BELIEVE**” AND “**FAITH**” ARE USED INTERCHANGEABLY.
- “**BELIEF**” AND “**FAITH**” ARE TRANSLATIONS OF THE SAME GREEK WORD.

John 3:16 – “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.”

Hebrews 11:6 – “But without faith it is impossible to please him ...”

Mark 16:16 – “He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.”

Acts 8:37 – “... If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest ...”

1 Corinthians 1:21 – “... It pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.”



FAITH IS A NECESSITY

- Man must believe or else die in his sins — **John 8:24**
- Man must believe or be damned — **Mark 16:16**
- Without faith man cannot please God — **Hebrews 11:6**
- Without faith man cannot be saved — **John 16:31**
- Faith is a part of salvation — **Ephesians 2:8**
- Faith without works is dead — **James 2:17, 26**
- True faith yields to God’s will — **Romans 10:16**
