

Who Should Be Withdrawn From?

- **WITHDRAW FROM THOSE THAT WALK DISORDERLY.** 2 Thessalonians 3:6
 - a. Withdraw means: “To separate from, to retire from personally and privately, as well as by public announcement, and to turn away from.”
 - b. Whatever a person does that is contrary to the teachings of the apostles is disorderly conduct.

- **WITHDRAW FROM THOSE THAT WILL NOT WORK.** 2 Thessalonians 3:16-14
 - 1. “Note that man”
 - 2. “Have no company with him”
 - 3. “That he may be ashamed”
 - 4. “Yet count him not as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother”

- **WITHDRAW FROM THOSE THAT TEACH THINGS CONTRARY TO SOUND DOCTRINE**
 - 1. Romans 16:17-18
 - 2. 1 Timothy 6:3-4
 - 3. 2 John 9-11
