AT BIRTH, ARE WE BORN IN SIN AS SOME DENOMINATIONALISTS SO TEACH?

- **Psalm 51:5** - Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me. (KJV)
- **Psalm 51:5** - Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And in sin my mother conceived me. (NKJV)
- **Deuteronomy 23:2** - A bastard shall not enter into the congregation of the LORD; even to his tenth generation shall he not enter into the congregation of the LORD. (KJV)
- **Deuteronomy 23:2** - One of illegitimate birth shall not enter the assembly of the LORD; even to the tenth generation none of his descendants shall enter the assembly of the LORD. (NKJV)

Ruth 4:18-22

18 Now this is the genealogy of Perez: **Perez** (1) begot **Hezron** (2);
19 Hezron begot **Ram** (3), and Ram begot **Amminadab** (4);

21 Salmon begot **Boaz** (7), and Boaz begot **Obed** (8);
22 Obed begot **Jesse** (9), and Jesse begot **David** (10).
