WHO SHOULD BE REBAPTIZED?

- 👉 **ALL WHO WERE IGNORANT OF THE PURPOSE OF BAPTISM**
 - Acts 22:16
 - John 8:32 - “KNOW” implies understanding

- 👉 **ALL WHO WERE BAPTIZED TO ENTER SOME DENOMINATIONAL CHURCH**
 - Romans 6:3
 - Galatians 6:3
 - 1 Corinthians 12;13

- 👉 **ALL WHO WERE NOT BURIED IN WATER (IMMERSED)**
 - Romans 6:3
 - Colossians 2:12

- 👉 **ALL WHO WERE NOT SINCERE ABOUT WHAT THEY WERE DOING WHEN THEY WERE BAPTIZED**

- Sincerity alone is not enough.
- Sprinkling is not scriptural baptism.
- Pouring (affusion) is not scriptural baptism.
- Infant baptism is not scriptural baptism.
- Immersion not for the remission of sins is not scriptural baptism.
- Immersion out of ignorance is not scriptural baptism.
- Baptism (immersion) for the remission of sins wherein the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ is reenacted is scriptural baptism.
 - 1 Corinthians 15:1-4
 - Romans 6:3-5
