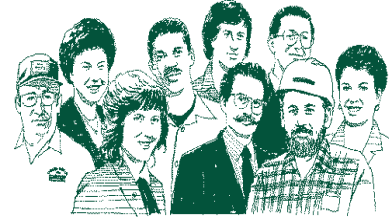


Church Discipline

DISCIPLINE – “Training or experience that corrects, molds, strengthens, or perfects.”

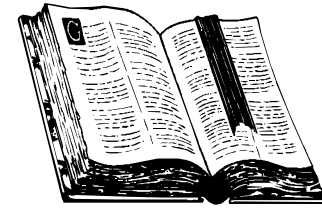
DISCIPLINE IS TWO-FOLD—

1. **INSTRUCTIVE** – Preventive in nature
2. **CORRECTIVE** – Chastising or penalizing in nature
