(Leviticus 1:8; 7:8) morning and evening (Exodus 29:38-39). • The skin was given to the priests. 	<p>Denoted total surrender to God as well as substitutionary atonement for offerer.</p> 	<p>Christ's total surrender to God on behalf of the believer (Hebrews 12:2-3) and His emptying of Himself to become sin for the sinner (2 Corinthians 5:21; Philippians 2:6-8).</p>
