| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PEACE OFFERING • Hebrew: Shelem • Leviticus 3:1-17; 7:11-21 • A sweet aroma and a freewill offering. • An unblemished male or female from cattle, sheep, or goats. • A bull or lamb could have a limb too short.  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fat on entrails, on breast, and on right thigh burned with kidneys on the altar of burnt offering (Leviticus 3:3-4) • Priests were give right thigh and breast (Leviticus 7:31-32) • Offerer and family ate remaining portions (Leviticus 7:15-17). • Only peace offerings were eaten by offerer.  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right relationship and friendship with God were represented by peace offerings and celebrated as a fellowship meal. • Peace offerings were rendered as thanksgiving for divine help and blessing.  | <p>Christians enjoy peace with God through Jesus Christ, their eternal Peace Offering (Romans 5:1).</p>  |
