## LILY

**Song of Solomon 6:2**

Probably the Madonna Lily.



## LILY

**Song of Solomon 5:13**

Probably the red lily that grows wild in the woods of Palestine.

## LILY OF THE VALLEY

**Song of Solomon 2:1-2; 4:5; 5:13; 6:2-3**

Probably the deep blue hyacinth that grows in the wild.

## MYRRH

**Song of Solomon 1:13; 3:6; 4:6, 14;  
5:1, 13**

A small thorny tree that produced a gum resin used as a spice.

## POMEGRANATE

**Song of Solomon 4:3, 13; 6:7, 11; 7,12; 8:2**

A round, leathery, skinned fruit containing many juicy seeds. I was very refreshing to eat..

## ROSE OF SHARON

**Song of Solomon 2:1**

Not the autumn blooming bush called by the same name, not the traditional rose. It is probably the red mountain tulip that grows wild in the plains of Sharon along the Mediterranean coast.

## SAFROM

**Song of Solomon 4:14**

Probably the autumn crocus.
