Heaven—The Best is Yet to Come!

1 Peter 1:3-5

INTRODUCTION:

A. **Illustration**: A woman was diagnosed with a terminal illness and had been given three months to live. As she was getting her things in order, she contacted her minister and asked him to come to her house to discuss some of her final wishes.

She told him which songs she wanted sung at her funeral service, what Scriptures she would like read, and what outfit she wanted to be buried in. She requested to be buried with her favorite Bible.

As the minister prepared to leave, the woman suddenly remembered something else. "There's one more thing," she said excitedly.

"What's that?" said the minister.

"This is important," the woman said. "I want to be buried with a fork in my right hand."

The minister stood looking at the woman, not knowing quite what to say.

The woman explained. "In all my years of attending church socials and potluck dinners, when the dishes of the main course were being cleared, someone would inevitably lean over and say, 'Keep your fork.' It was my favorite part of the meal because I knew something better was coming—like velvety chocolate cake or deep-dish apple pie.

"So, when people see me in that casket with a fork in my hand and they ask, 'What's with the fork?' I want you to tell them: 'Keep your fork. The best is vet to come!' "

Illustration: "There is a story told of a dying man who asked his Christian doctor to tell him something about the place to which he was going. - A. Heaven is a real place! John 14:1-3
 - 1. Heaven is not a fairytale!

- 2. Heaven is not imaginary!
- 3. Heaven is not a land of make-believe!
- 4. Heaven is real!
- B. All who will be there will be there to join that heavenly throng, will be there by choice. Revelation 19:6
 - 1. Yes . . . Heaven is a prepared place for a prepared people.
 - 2. Yes . . . Heaven is a chosen place by people who chose to obey and serve God.
- C. Heaven is a place where the ills of time will be no more. Revelation 21:4
- D. Heaven is a place of unimaginable joy.

 - 1. Christ makes you worthy of Heaven 1 John 1:7 ". . . The blood of Jesus, His Son, cleanses us from all sin."
 - 2. Heaven's gate is the door of your heart. Revelation 3:20 "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come to him and dine with him, and he with Me."
