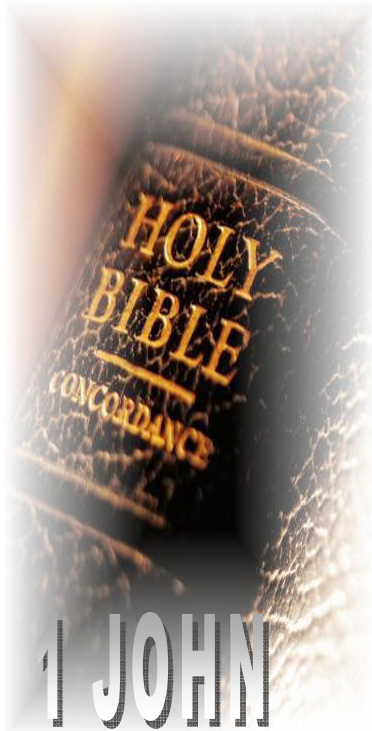


Life Lessons from 1 John
