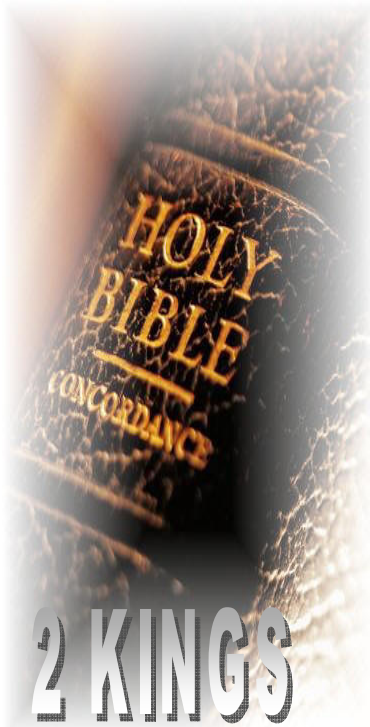


Life Lessons from 2 Kings
