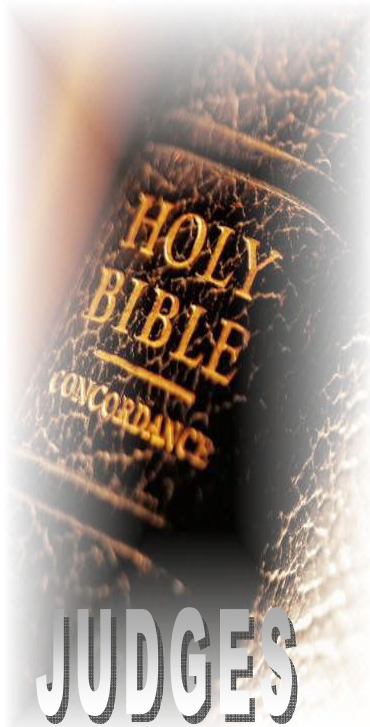


Life Lessons from Judges
