- ➔ **SELF-DARKNESS:** “They put out his eyes” (Judges 16:21)
- ➔ **SELF-DEGRADATION:** “They brought him down to Gaza” (Judges 16:1-3, 21)
- ➔ **SELF-BONDAGE:** “They bound him with bronze fetters” (Judges 16:21)
- ➔ **SELF-DRUDGERY:** “He became a grinder in the prison” (Judges 16:21)
- ➔ **SELF-HUMILIATION:** “Call for Samson, that he may perform for us” (Judges 16:25, 27)
