

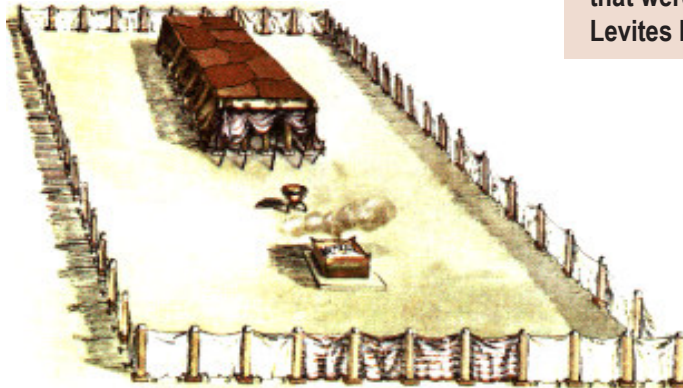
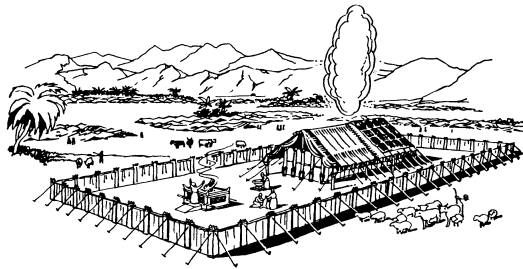
Tabernacle Facts - Part 1

- “Tent of Jehovah”
- “The Sanctuary”

MATERIALS FOR BUILDING THE TABERNACLE

- **Metals**
 - Gold
 - Silver
 - Brass
- **Fabrics**
 - Blue
 - Purple
 - Scarlet
 - Fine white linen
- **Wood**
 - Shittim wood of the wild acacia desert
- **Oil, spices, and incense**
 - For anointing the priests
 - For burning in the Tabernacle



BUILDERS

- Superintendent - Bezalel (tribe of Judah)
- Assistant - Aholiab (tribe of Dan)

HISTORY OF THE TABERNACLE

- Construction (Exodus 35:6 - 40:38)
- During the conquest of Canaan, the Ark of the Covenant remained in the camp at Gilgal
- After the settlement of Israel, the tabernacle was set up at Shiloh
- With the capture of the Ark of the Covenant by the Philistines, the tabernacle lost its glory and value.
- The Tabernacle merged with the Temple in
 - 1 Kings 8:4
 - 2 Chronicles 5:5
