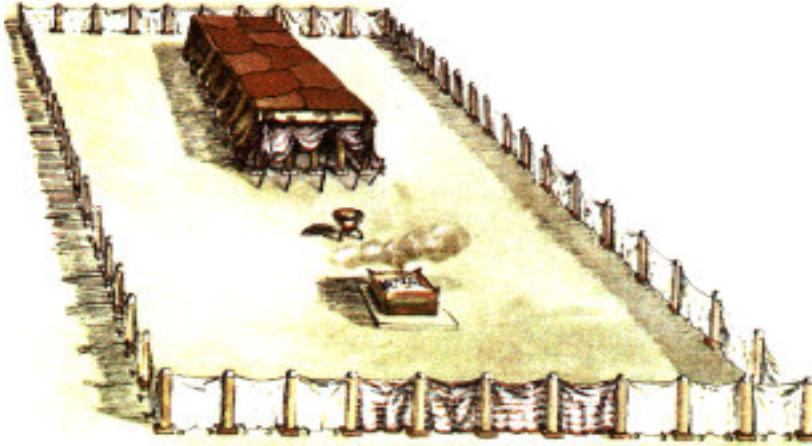
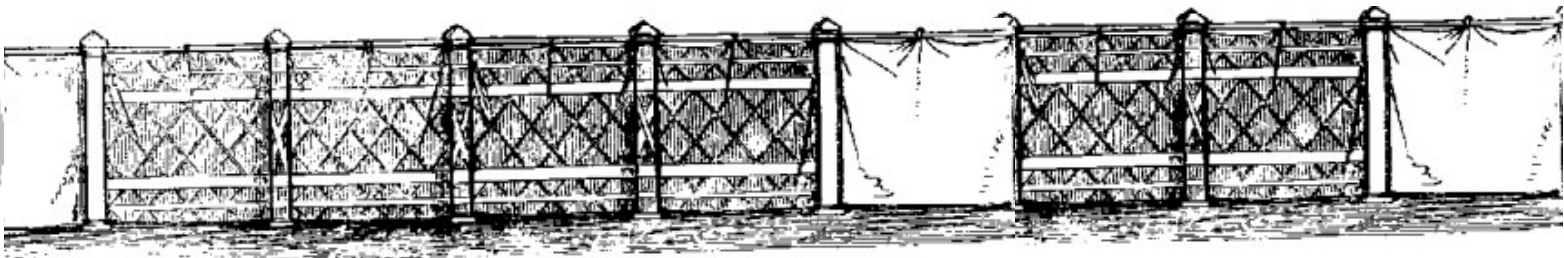


Tabernacle Facts - Part 4



- Approximately 6,000 sq. ft. of fine linen was used in the tabernacle and priest robes.
- The Fence contained 60 pillars (posts),



GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE TABERNACLE

- The most costly building for its size every erected.
- It was 15 ft. wide, 45 ft. long. and 15 ft. high.
- The two rooms of the Tabernacle (Holy Place and Holy of Holies) contained approximately 675 sq. ft. of floor space
- The cost of materials was over \$10,000,000.00, not counting labor.
- The Tabernacle building itself:
 1. Stood within a court that was about the size of an average city lot - 75 x 150
 2. Enclosed by a fence 1½ ft. high
 3. Had one door of entrance - Facing east
