John 9:35-37

INTRODUCTION:

A. Who is Jesus?

1. To a blind man that had just been healed, Jesus asked in **John 9:35-37** - "Do you believe in the Son of God?" He answered and said, "Who is He, Lord, that I may believe in Him?" And Jesus said to him, 'You have both seen Him and it is He who is talking with you.'"
2. Some scholars have located over 700 titles and different names for Jesus in the Bible. Others concentrate of much shorter lists.

B. He is my Savior and I hope you have made Him your Savior as well.

C. In **Acts 9:5** Saul of Tarsus asked, "Who are you, Lord?"

D. In **Matthew 27:11**, Pilate asked, ". . . 'Are You the King of the Jews?' Jesus said to Him, "It is as you say."

Let me tell you about Him.

My King was born King. The Bible says He's a Seven-Way King:

1. He's the King of the Jews – That's an **Ethnic** King.
2. He's the King of Israel – That's a **National** King.
3. He's the King of righteousness – That's a **Spiritual** King
4. He's the king of the ages – That's an **Ageless** King
5. He's the King of glory – That's a **Heavenly** King
6. He's the King of kings and He is the Lord of Lords – That's a **Matchless** King
7. He's the King of my life – That's a Personal King
