

The Holy Ghost - “The Holy Guest”

- The preferred designation is **The Holy Guest**
- The King James translation renders it “The Holy Ghost”
- To many the term “Holy Ghost” suggests:
 - Something mysterious
 - Something frightening
 - Something like “Casper” or other ghostly characters
 - Some power of feeling that produces some sort of emotional excitement or hysteria
- In 1611 when the king James translation was made, it meant “HOLY GUEST.” With the change of language involving the word “ghost,” the designation “HOLY SPIRIT” seems more appropriate.
