



# The Theological Meaning of the Table

1 Corinthians 11:23-29 & Matthew 26:26-29

- The forerunner, shadow, type of the Lord's Supper was the Passover. *Matthew 26:17-18, 26-29*
- Not all covenants entered become covenants faithfully kept. *2 Kings 23:21-23*
- Christ is our Passover: Body (bread) Blood (fruit of the vine). *1 Corinthians 5:7*
- The Lord's Supper is to be kept faithfully by the keepers of the New Covenant. *Acts 20:7*

5. An observance with precious memories.
6. A fellowship of Divine Host with human guests.
7. Not to be eaten without faith, obedience, and commitment.
