DENOMINATIONAL BAPTISM IS WRONG BECAUSE . . .

IT HAS THE WRONG CONFESSION

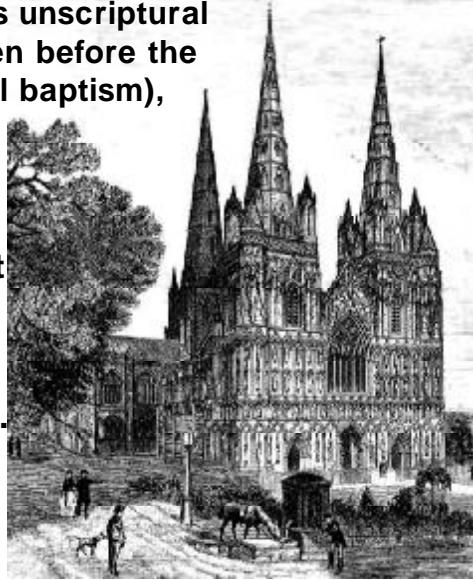


- The denominational confession, “God for Christ’s sake pardoned my sins” prior to baptism is unscriptural
- Believing one’s sins have been forgiven before the blood of Christ is reached (in Biblical baptism), is wrong.

THE BIBLE TEACHES . . .

- ☞ The proper confession to precede baptism is, “I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God” (Acts 8:35-38)
- ☞ Baptism is to save, but it does not save apart from the blood of Christ.
