- “There were hypocrites in the church.”
  - Witness: The 11 apostles (Matthew 26:47-50)
- “I thought I had plenty of time.”
  - Witness: The 5 foolish virgins (Matthew 25:1-13)
- “I was afraid that I couldn’t hold out.”
  - Witness: Peter (Matthew 26:33-35; John 18:16-27)
