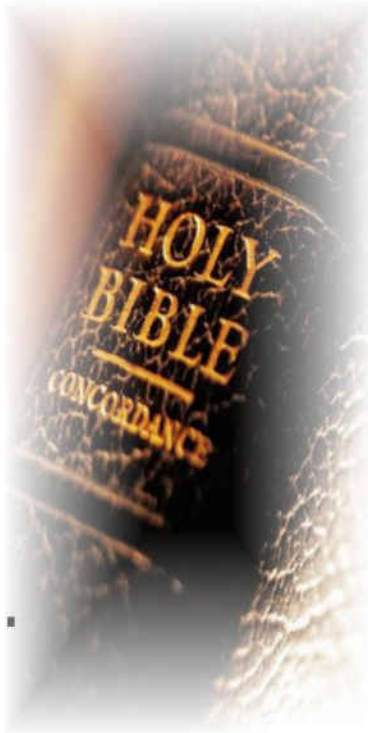


Life Lessons from Lamentations
